Description: Vimentin is the main intermediate filament protein in mesenchymal cells and is therefore of value in the differential diagnosis of undifferentiated neoplasms.

Source: Bovine Lens

Formulation: Bovine Vimentin protein lyophilized from a 1 mg/ml solution containing 10 mM sodium phosphate pH 7.5 + 6 M urea + 2 mM DTT + 1 mM EDTA + 10 mM methylammonium chloride.

Storage & Stability: Stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. For long term usage please store vial at -20°C to -80°C. When stored at the recommended temperature, this protein is stable for 12 months.
