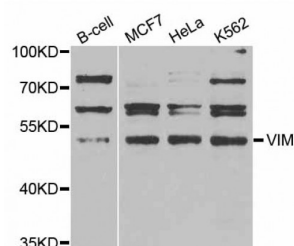


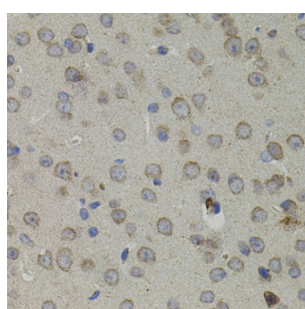

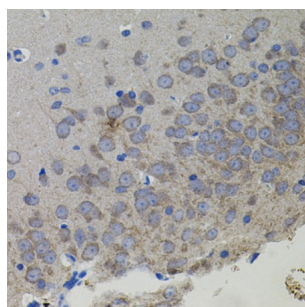

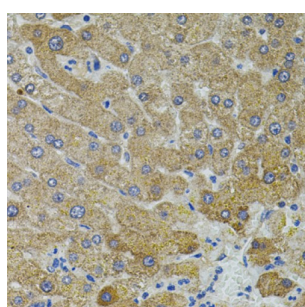
Western blot analysis of extracts of various cell lines, using VIM antibody (abx126784) at 1/1000 dilution.



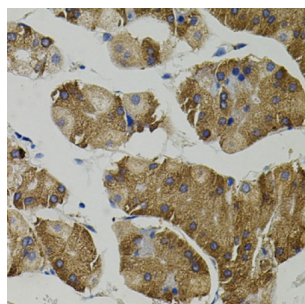
Immunohistochemistry of paraffin-embedded mouse brain using VIM antibody (abx126784) at dilution of 1/100 (40x lens).
