Description: Ephrin-A5, a member of the ephrin gene family, prevents

> axon bundling in cocultures of cortical neurons with astrocytes, a model of late stage nervous system

development and differentiation. The EPH and EPH-related receptors comprise the largest subfamily of receptor proteintyrosine kinases and have been implicated in mediating developmental events, particularly in the nervous system. EPH receptors typically have a single kinase domain and an extracellular region containing a Cys-rich domain and 2 fibronectin type III repeats. The ephrin ligands and receptors have been named by the Eph Nomenclature Committee

(1997). Based on their structures and sequence

relationships, ephrins are divided into the ephrin-A (EFNA)

class, which are anchored to the membrane by a glycosylphosphatidylinositol linkage, and the ephrin-B (EFNB) class, which are transmembrane proteins. The Eph family of receptors are similarly divided into 2 groups based on the similarity of their extracellular domain sequences and their affinities for binding ephrin-A and ephrin-B ligands


Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline, pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol. Store at -20

°C.Stable for 12 months from date of receipt.



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
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Western blot analysis on HeLa cell lysate using EFNA5 Ab,The lane on the left is treated with the antigen-specific peptide.



AF0560 at 1/100 staining human lung carcinoma tissue sections by IHC-P. The tissue was formaldehyde fixed and a heat mediated antigen retrieval step in citrate buffer was performed. The tissue was then blocked and incubated with the Ab for 1.5 hours at 22°C. An HRP conjugated goat antirabbit Ab was used as the secondary.



AF0560 staining HeLa by IF/ICC. The sample were fixed with PFA and permeabilized in 0.1% Triton X-100,then blocked in 10% serum for 45 minutes at 25°C. The primary Ab was diluted at 1/200 and incubated with the sample for 1 hour at 37°C. An Alexa Fluor 594 conjugated goat anti-rabbit IgG (H+L) Ab, diluted at 1/600, was used as the secondary Ab.
