

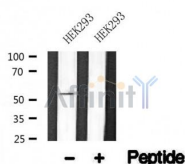
## PTEN Ab

Reactivity:	Human,Mouse,Rat
Purification:	The antiserum was purified by peptide affinity chromatography using SulfoLink™ Coupling Resin (Thermo Fisher Scientific).
Specificity:	PTEN Ab detects endogenous levels of PTEN.
Immunogen:	A synthesized peptide derived from human PTEN.
Uniprot:	P60484
Subcellular Location:	Secreted. May be secreted via a classical signal peptide and reenter into cells with the help of a poly-Arg motif and Cytoplasm. Nucleus. Nucleus, PML body. Monoubiquitinated form is nuclear. Nonubiquitinated form is cytoplasmic. Colocalized with PML and USP7 in PML nuclear bodies. XIAP/BIRC4 promotes its nuclear localization.
Tissue Specificity:	Expressed at a relatively high level in all adult tissues, including heart, brain, placenta, lung, liver, muscle, kidney and pancreas.
Similarity:	The C2 domain binds phospholipid membranes in vitro in a Ca <sup>2+</sup> -independent manner; this binding is important for its tumor suppressor function.
Storage Condition and Buffer:	Rabbit IgG in phosphate buffered saline , pH 7.4, 150mM NaCl, 0.02% sodium azide and 50% glycerol.Store at -20 °C.Stable for 12 months from date of receipt.

**IMPORTANT:** For western blot, incubate membrane with diluted primary Ab in 5% w/v milk , 1X TBS, 0.1% Tween@20 at 4°C with gentle shaking,
